**Verses that touch on the movements of the women between the time of the burial of Jesus Christ to His resurrection.**

<b>Gospel of Matthew</b>	<b>Reference to the women at the sepulchre and with regards to the spices in relation to the Sabbath</b>
Matthew 27:60 – 61 And laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock: and he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed. And there was Mary Magdalene, and the other Mary, sitting over against the sepulchre.	

<b>Gospel of Mark</b>	<b>Reference to the women at the sepulchre and with regards to the spices in relation to the Sabbath</b>
Mark 15:46 – 16:1 And he bought fine linen, and took him down, and wrapped him in the linen, and laid him in a sepulchre which was hewn out of a rock, and rolled a stone unto the door of the sepulchre. And Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joses beheld where he was laid. clearly states that the women bought the spices to anoint Jesus AFTER the sabbath had past. And when the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought sweet spices, that they might come and anoint him.	

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<b>Gospel of Luke</b>	<b>Reference to the women at the sepulchre and with regards to the spices in relation to the Sabbath</b>
<p>Luke 23:53 – 55          And he took it down, and wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a sepulchre that was hewn in stone, wherein never man before was laid.          And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on.          And the women also, which came with him from Galilee, followed after, and beheld the sepulchre, and how his body was laid.          And they returned, and prepared spices and ointments; and rested the sabbath day according to the commandment.</p>
